Vinny & Mikalya Fischer are a young, adventurous, loving and faithful couple who just celebrated their 2nd anniversary. Sadly, they were in a life-threatening motorcycle accident on October 21, leaving Vinny with a severed leg and internal injuries, and Mikayla with several broken bones on her left side. Vinny, 24, is currently in the ICU at Brigham and Women's until he is ready to be transferred to a rehab facility for several months. Mikayla, 23, had several surgeries at Tufts Medical Center and was transferred to a rehab facility nearby. They are looking forward to finally seeing each other for the first time since the accident. Vinny and his family are long-time residents of East Berlin and are involved with several community parishes. His mom, Dawn, works at Willard School and Wellspring Church, and his dad, Bob, owned a woodworking shop in town;

in fact, he and Vinny built the doors on St. Paul Church. Vinny graduated from BHS in 2011, a member of UpBeat and the soccer and swim teams. He is also an Eagle Scout and is pursuing a degree in engineering. He met Mikayla through a church retreat in middle school, immediately knowing she was the one, and they married in 2015. Mikayla graduated from Mass. College of Pharmacy with her nursing degree in only 3 years. While they have enough faith and love to get them through this, they both face a long road to recovery and astronomical medical costs.
